

# FULL SUTTON AND SKIRPENBECK PARISH COUNCIL

The minutes of the Meeting of the Full Sutton and Skirpenbeck Parish Council held at Bugthorpe War Memorial Institute at 7.30 pm Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> January 2011.

## Open Forum

Mr Donald Grayson addressed the meeting regarding his hopes for a memorial for the soldiers from Full Sutton Airbase who lost their lives in combat. Various options are available but it was thought that the most suitable would be a plaque in the church near to the existing one to mark those who lost their lives in the Great War. He would be prepared to give a donation to this and hoped that the Parish Council would contribute financially to it as well. He will research similar memorials and report back to the Parish Council. Councillors thanked Mr Grayson for coming and the item would be discussed later in the meeting.

1. **Present:** The Chairman Councillor R Nightingale and Councillors R Westmoreland, E Keam, S Parkinson, M Dale, E Price, G Ellis and C Collier.
2. The minutes of the Full Sutton and Skirpenbeck Parish Council meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2010 were confirmed. Matters arising there from to be dealt with under the relevant heading of the Agenda as the Agenda is progressed.
3. **Declaration of Interest.** Councillor Nightingale declared a prejudicial interest in Item 5, planning and advised that he would be making a statement on the application. There were no further declarations of interest made by those present in respect to items on the agenda.
4. **East Riding Items of Interest.** Councillor Dee Sharpe was invited to attend but did not come to the meeting.
5. **Planning.**
  - **DC/10/05016/PLF/WESTWW** Change of use and alterations to agricultural buildings to form leisure and tourism accommodation at Street Farm for Mr R Nightingale. Application type: Full Planning Permission. Councillor Nightingale advised that the traditional brick buildings were on the verge of collapse so a decision had been taken to try and convert them into holiday accommodation which is in line with the existing holiday park. Councillor Nightingale left the room. The plans were viewed and discussed. Councillor Ellis proposed that the plans should be approved, this was seconded by Councillor Collier and all present voted in favour. Councillor Nightingale returned.

## Notice of Decision

- **DC/10/0491/VAR/WESTWW/TWILLI** Removal of condition 2 of planning permission 07/05234/PLF relating to play equipment at Skirpenbeck Play Area for Full Sutton and Skirpenbeck Parish Council. This application has been refused; the Clerk has spoken to Tim Williams the case officer and he has advised that a new application should be submitted to seek approval for the trim trail to remain in its current position and also to apply for any future equipment. The Clerk and Councillor Collier will meet to arrange for this.
