The minutes of the Meeting of the Full Sutton and Skirpenbeck Parish Council held in Low Catton Village Hall at 8.00 pm Thursday 13th May 2010.

Open Forum

No members of the public were present.

1. **Present:** The Chairman Councillor R Nightingale and Councillors R Westmoreland, C Collier and E Price. Apologies for absence were received from Councillors E Keam, M Dale, G Ellis and S Bond.
2. The minutes of the Full Sutton and Skirpenbeck Parish Council meeting held on 15th April 2010 were confirmed. Matters arising there from to be dealt with under the relevant heading of the Agenda as the Agenda is progressed.
3. **Declaration of Interest.** There were no declarations of interest made by those present in respect to items on the agenda.

4. **Planning**

Notice of decision

- **DC/10/01645/PLF/WESTWW** Construction of chimney stack to rear at Fielding Court, West Croft Farm, Main Street, Skirpenbeck for Mr D Grayson. Application type: Full Planning Permission. The plans were viewed and Councillors recommended approval.
5. **Finance.** Payment was authorised on the following account:

 6. **Highways and Footways.** Councillor Nightingale will complete the Parish Paths Grant Application Form.
 7. **Police.** There were no matters for discussion.
 8. **Communal Play Area.** The Parish Council welcomed Harriet Linfoot (HL), YWT, to discuss the play area. HL advised that there is still £1700.00 left to spend following the planting of the trees. She has sourced a company who design and make one-off pieces of outside seats and sculptures. The designer bases the design on local history and it was agreed that this would be a wonderful opportunity to have something 'different'. The money will also be used to purchase some 'mushroom seating' and a raised manger from planting. HL will co-ordinate an event to involve the local children when the pieces are all ready and they can be involved in planting the manger; this is expected to be in time for the summer holidays. The play area may also feature in the next Yorkshire Wildlife Trust magazine. Councillors thanked HL for coming and for her hard work. The Clerk advised that she had received a letter from the Enforcement Officer following an enquiry regarding the placing of the equipment. ERYC have requested a copy of the plan but there was no cause for concern. Councillor Collier has requested the plan from Mike Metcalf but the Clerk is yet to receive it.
 9. **Questions from Councillors.** Councillor Price has spoken to Rev'd Finnemore regarding the possibility of the memorial being placed in the church yard. He saw no problem with this in theory but a faculty would be required. All Councillors present were in favour of supporting Mr Grayson's idea of a memorial and suggest that he puts a proposal together to show the Parish Council and then a decision can be taken as to what assistance and support is required.
 10. **Administration Matters.**
 - Correspondence received. The Clerk gave details of the 60/40 street lighting proposal; Councillors agreed that there was no requirement for this in either village.

11. **Date and Venue of next meeting.** The next Parish Council Meeting will be held on Thursday 17th June at Bugthorpe War Memorial Institute at 7.30 pm. The meeting was closed at 9.10 pm.
