The Minutes of the Meeting of Full Sutton & Skirpenbeck Parish Council held in the Training Centre, HMP Full Sutton at 7.30pm on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2019. The meeting started at 8.18pm due to the late finish of the Annual Parish Meeting and AGM.

### **OPEN FORUM**

There was 1 member of the public present. He informed the PC that the grass at the Play Area was long and in need of a cut. SB to contact Trevor Lee. As there were no other comments SB closed the Open Forum at 8.20pm.

The meeting started at 8.21pm.

1. **Present:** Chairman S Barnes and Cllrs S Davies, A Findlay, C Stephens and the Clerk. Apologies received from Cllr D Flynn. Ward Councillor Leo Hammond was in attendance as was Cllr A Dykes, Dunnington Parish.
2. **Code of Conduct.**
  - a) To receive Declarations of Interest from members of the Council on matters relating to the Agenda. All Cllrs had pecuniary interest in item 6c. SB declared a non-pecuniary interest in Item 8. AF declared a pecuniary interest in item 7a
  - b) To note the granting of any dispensations to members of the Council on matters relating to the Agenda. The Clerk had issued Dispensations to all Cllrs for Item 6c.
3. The Minutes of the Full Sutton & Skirpenbeck Parish Council meeting held on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> April 2019 were confirmed as a true record. SD proposed, CS seconded and all agreed. The Minutes were duly signed.
4. Ward Cllr Leo Hammond gave an overview of ERYC's current position. SB thanked him for attending.

  - a) Notification of Decision 19/00629/PLF: Internal and external alterations including erection of single storey extension to side, erection of a detached double garage. Location: 1 Bleach Farm Cottages, Roman Road, Stamford Bridge YO41 1SA. Applicant: Mr Sellers. Permission granted. Noted.
  - b) Notification of Decision 19/00298/PLF: Erection of single-story extension to rear following demolition of existing porch and store room. Location: Jasmine Cottage, Hatkill Lane, Full Sutton, YO41 1HW. Applicant: Mr Craig Cooper. Permission granted. Noted.
  - c) Strategic Outline Planning Permission 18/04105/STOUT: Erection of prison complex with associated perimeter fencing, access, parking, landscaping and infrastructure (access and scale to be considered). Location: land to the west of HM Prison Full Sutton, Moor Lane, Full Sutton, YO41 1PS. Applicant: The Secretary of State for Justice. Deadline passed but objections can be sent in up to a few days before the Planning Committee meeting. Planning Committee not likely to consider this application before the 11<sup>th</sup> July. PC happy to pay for another set of 6 banners to replace the ones that have been taken, Cllrs would like #Full Sutton Prison (could be checked with the PR Consultant) to be added. The PC had received a reply from Stephen Hunt regarding the promise of a Public Enquiry, Clerk to draft a response and circulate to Cllrs.
