The Minutes of the Meeting of Full Sutton & Skirpenbeck Parish Council (PC) held via Webex at 7.00pm on Monday 6th July 2020. No members of the public had requested a link to the meeting.

OPEN FORUM

There were no members of the public present.

1. **Present:** Chairman S Davies (SD) and Cllrs M Edwards (ME), A Findlay (AF), D Flynn (DF), D Roberts (DR), F Roberts (FR) and the Clerk. Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr L Chapman (LC). Ward Cllr Leo Hammond (LH) was also present. Due to the ongoing situation with COVID 19, SD proposed that the PC should approve the non-attendance of members until May 2021. DF seconded and all agreed.
2. **Code of Conduct.**
 - a) To receive Declarations of Interest from members of the Council on matters relating to the Agenda. ME declared a pecuniary interest in Items 7f and 8d.
 - b) To note the granting of any dispensations to members of the Council on matters relating to the Agenda. There were no dispensations.
3. The Minutes of the Full Sutton & Skirpenbeck Parish Council meeting held on Monday 16th March 2020 were agreed as a true record. FR proposed, ME seconded and all agreed. The Minutes were duly signed.
4. The Minutes of the meeting of the Personnel Committee held on the 16th March 2020 were agreed as a true record. ME proposed, FR seconded and all agreed. The Minutes were duly signed.
5. Ward Councillor Leo Hammond (LH) reported that there have been 300 deaths in the East Riding due to COVID 19 with 109 of them being in care homes. Currently there are 16 cases, down from a peak of 179. Community spirit continues to be high with villages continuing with their volunteer groups.
6. **Clerk Update.** The Clerk updated Councillors on the following:
 - a) An application had been received from a resident of Skirpenbeck for the Vacancy. Clerk to invite him to the next meeting.
 - b) There had been a complaint regarding dog fouling from a resident of Godwin Vale. ME had kindly offered to distribute awareness postcards around the estate giving details of the ERYC dog warden service.
 - c) There had been a question of ownership of some trees backing onto Harthill Crescent. LH had been asked to look into this and had found that ERYC were responsible for the land up to the ditch and anything beyond that is the householders' responsibility. LH will seek to clarify whether the trees are the joint responsibility of the householders (riparian owned).
 - d) There had been a number of issues reported by a resident of Godwin Vale that had been passed on to Planning Enforcement at ERYC.
7. **Planning.**
